IN MEMORIAM – GEORGE TRAMOUNTANAS

He was the first Greek to step foot in South Australia in 1842.

The first Greek settler George Tramountanas was born in Lemnos Greece in 1822.

He was a seaman on sailing ships and had travelled to Australia on previous occasions before arriving at Port Adelaide in 1842.

Family oral history notes that George arrived in 1842 with his brother Theodore, who went alone to Albany in Western Australia never to be heard from again.

George remained in Adelaide. The Greek Orthodox Community of S.A. in conjunction with the George "North" Tramountanas Association will hold a memorial service commemorating the 200th Year Anniversary of his birth and 180 years from his arrival in South Australia.

The memorial service will take place on Saturday 29th of October at the Migration Museum, 82 Kintore Avenue, Adelaide, at 3.00pm.
