LECTURE ON THE IKARIAN MIGRATION

As last year marked the 200th Year Anniversary of the Greek War of Independence and the 90th Anniversary of the Greek Orthodox Community of South Australia, the Odyssey Festival theme is following this milestone by presenting a series of lectures focusing on Hellenism beyond the Greek borders following Greece's War of Independence as well as the first establishments of the Greek communities in South Australia.

This second lecture has been scheduled for Sunday 23rd of October 2022 at the Ikarian Hall and will be presented by PhD candidate Yianni Cartledge.

Mr Cartledge is doing research on the Greek emigration to Australia in the earlier and later years.

This lecture looks at Ikarian emigration from the Aegean region to South Australia between 1910-1945 (loosely corresponding to the period between Federation and WWII).

Of focus will be their settlement and initial community building, especially in key locations in South Australia such as Port Pirie and the Adelaide CBD. The research is a component of a larger PhD project aimed at exploring Aegean islander migration to the English-speaking world between 1815-1945 – with the Ikarians of South Australia (1900-1945) being one case study, alongside the Chiois of London (1815-1900).

The ways in which these migrants emigrated, settled, built communities, and integrated into wider Anglophone society, as well as the multiple identities that they navigated, are considered, contemplated, and unravelled in this project.

The lecture is scheduled for 2.00pm at the Ikarian Hall, 24 Arthur Street, Unley.
